Your unit could be genre (personal narrative, fiction, fairy tales, informational texts, persuasive texts such as speeches or presentations, etc.) or craft based (for example, illustration studies, how authors use punctuation in interesting ways, etc.). Participants will need to bring a minimum of 10 mentor texts for the unit they want to develop.
