Students grieve deeply and require support to move through the challenges and distress accompanying loss. Please join Dr. Linita Eapen Mathew as she explores the presence of student grief in Canadian schools. The session will define student grief, discuss the effect of trauma on the brain and learning, and provide educators with examples of how storytelling can support student grief work in the classroom. Using the art of structured storytelling, educators are guided on how to help students actively process and reconcile death and living losses.

Linita Eapen Mathew is a Student Services Learning Leader within the CBE and a graduate course instructor through Athabasca University and the University of Calgary. In 2021, she completed her Doctor of Education through the University of Calgary, specializing in bringing grief work and death education to schools. Her two books, *Life: To Be*

Given Back Again to Whence It Came (Winner of the 2024 IAANI's Outstanding Book Award) and The Revelations of Eapen, promote death education and teach educators and professional practitioners how to use storytelling to effectively process and reconcile with the death of a loved one. In 2024, she opened the Eapen Mathew Grief Centre to provide compassionate grief support services for the bereaved.
